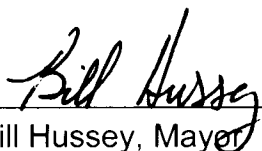
Reminded the community to cut back on brush and stay on top of trimmings and proper dumping to reduce the potential of fires in the area.

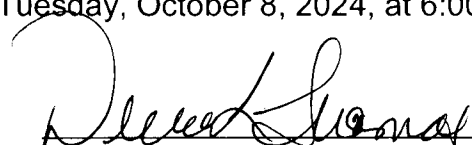
